## Fabric:

- ✂ Kit Available
- or
- ✂ See pattern for size and design option

## Notions/Supplies:

- ✂ Hoop Requirements for Little Red: 14" requires Bernina large oval or Bernina midi hoop; 16" requires Bernina midi hoop; 18" requires Bernina maxi hoop
- ✂ Hoop Requirements for the Wolf: 14" requires Bernina large oval or Bernina midi hoop; 16" and 18" requires Bernina Maxi Hoop
- ✂ Basic sewing supplies such as rotary cutter, rulers, pins, etc
- ✂ USB stick with designs
- ✂ Lightweight tearaway stabilizer
- ✂ No show mesh cut away stabilizer
- ✂ Fusible cutaway stabilizer (pattern calls for this for Little Red's pigtails but I didn't use)
- ✂ Neutral color bobbin thread
- ✂ Black bobbin thread
- ✂ Paper tape
- ✂ Polyester fiberfill
- ✂ 75/11 sharp Organ embroidery needles
- ✂ Hemostats at least 8"
- ✂ Curved applique scissors
- ✂ Turning tool
- ✂ Needle and matching thread to sew the bottom of the doll closed
- ✂ Isacord thread colors: 0010, 0020, 1061, 1115, 1352, 1366, 1565, 1761, 1912, 2113, 5822

## Notes:

There are a couple of pieces of fabric that need to be pieced for Little Red and the Wolf before you can start the embroidery. You will need to bring thread and appropriate presser feet for your machine or do these steps at home before class.

Pattern designer Jennifer Long has a video on the Riley Blake Designs YouTube channel that demonstrates how the Little Red doll goes together in the hoop, how the limbs are turned right side out and stuffed.

The 16" doll will fit in the midi hoop if you reduce the arms/apron design file to 98%. The legs and pigtails design file needs to be moved (X:33, Y:-48) to fit in the midi hoop stitching area.

- ✂ Basic Sewing Supplies and Machine Embroidery Supplies

Please bring your sewing machine and embroidery module in good working order.

Basic Sewing Supplies and machine embroidery supplies - Machine, rulers, rotary cutter, thread, scissors, pins, seam ripper, etc.

## **QUILTIQUE CLASS POLICY (Revised 12/30/22)**

### Sewing Machine

- All brands of sewing machines are welcome! A BERNINA sewing machine may be rented for a \$7.50 rental fee (plus tax) per class/per day which includes basic and specialty presser feet. Please inform the front desk at time of class sign-up if you will need a sewing machine for your class. Rentals are not available for Mastery Classes or Embroidery Classes.

### Basic Class Supplies Needed

- Quality Sewing Thread such as Aurifil®
- Medium size cutting mat (18"x24")
- Rotary cutter
- Favorite quilting ruler for cutting strips (at least 6" x 18")
- Seam ripper, pins, scissors, etc.

### Other Supplies

- All class attendees must have a legal copy of the class pattern/book (if required) to participate.
  - Absolutely no photocopies allowed in class and no sharing of patterns or books.
- A class supply list will be supplied to you at time of class enrollment.
- A class supply discount will be offered on listed supplies the day you enroll only (not on class day).
- All class participants are asked to purchase supplies PRIOR to class to avoid disruption of class time
  - Exception: Beginning Quilting students will get supplies during 1<sup>st</sup> class with discount

### Class Sign-up

- Class sign-ups for the current class schedule begin on the scheduled *Class Kickoff Day*. No sign ups will be accepted before this date. However, sign-ups for classes with special guest teachers, BOM's, and most other special events are open anytime.

### Class Fees

- The Class Fee must be collected when you sign up for the class to guarantee your seat.
- Due to popularity of classes and in fairness, Quiltique will not "hold" a seat for you without payment.

### Refunds

- There are no Class Fee refunds – only Class Fee store credit.
- If you must cancel a class, you will receive a credit in the amount of the class fee to be used later towards another class fee only. Your credit is good for 6 months from date of cancellation, not date of class.
- If you cancel the day of class or "no-show" - No credit will be issued regardless of reason.
- PIECE MAKING BASICS – If you miss the first class of PMB, you cannot continue the remaining sessions. You will forfeit \$25 and be given a \$75 credit good toward any other class fee.

### Cancellation

- A minimum of 1 student is required for class. If this requirement is not met within 14 days of class date, the class will be cancelled.
- Quiltique reserves the right to cancel classes for any reason. If this happens, you will be refunded your full class fee and/or supplies.

### Class Time

- Please BE ON TIME in consideration of the teacher and other students
- Please silence cellular phones. If a call is necessary, please leave the room to complete the call.
- Please DO NOT WEAR PERFUME to class due to allergies of others.
- Children or pets are not permitted in class for any reason.

### Class Participants

- Students must be at least 16 years old. Students between the ages of 10-15 may attend class only with parental supervision. A waiver of liability must be signed.

### SPECIAL EVENT CLASSES (NATIONAL TEACHERS)

- **Full payment for Special Events/National Teachers is due at time of sign up**
- **There are NO REFUNDS within 30 days of class date**
  - **You may send a friend in your spot.**
  - Quiltique will make efforts to fill your spot. If we are successful, you will receive a refund for your class fee. This is not guaranteed.
